Code of Ethics

- ESA members may provide additional information on further tests or remediation as long as "No-Conflict of Interest" are present.
- ESA members should be aware of federal, state, or local laws of the area which may apply to, their testing or remediation.
- ESA members shall not withhold any pertinent information from their clients regardless of the outcome.
- ESA members shall not be influenced by any other parties in changing their conclusions for personal gain.
- ESA members shall not disclose any information to any other entities other than their clients.
- ESA members shall maintain their professionalism to their clients through continuing educational training.
